Hello Parents and Guardians,

I hope everyone is healthy and safe as we continue to adapt to the pandemic.

We all know the very best educational experience for your children is time with their teacher(s). And as we have done throughout the pandemic, the district continues to monitor local, county, and regional health statistics; thankfully, the health numbers are stabilizing and moving in a healthier direction.


Based on the health information, the Rahway Board of Education voted to approve my recommendation that the district **change the elementary schedule on May 3, 2021 to more resemble a typical school day**. Please note that grades 7-12 have been attending school following a somewhat typical school day since we opened on March 15 and so there is no change to the schedule for grades 7-12 on May 3.

Please understand that we are lengthening the instructional time for the students. Your child(ren) will remain in their current teaching mode; eg. If your child is in Hybrid Group A they will continue to be in Hybrid Group A, etc.

Building-specific details will be coming from the principals over the next weeks as the principals and other administrators iron out the logistics.

Please continue to be vigilant with following mitigation strategies in place to keep us all healthy: stay home when sick, wear a mask, practice social distancing, and wash your hands regularly. Together we can all get through this pandemic!
